

A research study to investigate the safety and effectiveness of lurasidone in children and adolescents with bipolar depression

Who: Dr. Robert Findling is recruiting for a research study involving children and adolescents, ages 10 to 17 years old, for a study drug called lurasidone (Latuda®). The purpose of this research study is to determine whether lurasidone is safe and effective in children and /adolescents with bipolar depression.

What: During 9 conveniently scheduled clinic visits over the course of 10 weeks, participants will receive psychological, behavioral, and medical testing, including behavioral assessments, physical examinations, blood draws, vital signs, ECGs, urine drug screen, and pregnancy testing for females. Study visits will last about 2 to 4 hours on average although some may be longer. Follow-up phone calls will also occur between study visits. This research study is sponsored by Sunovion.
