

CHILDREN'S RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES



You have the right to:

- Be treated kindly and with respect
- Have your questions answered in words you understand
- Be as comfortable and pain-free as possible
- Be safe
- Be called the name you like
- Know the names of the people who take care of you
- Make your own choices whenever possible
- Have your parent or caregiver with you as much as possible
- Have someone speak to you in the language you know best, whenever possible
- Have as much privacy as possible

You are responsible for:

- Speaking with your team when you have any questions
- Being honest
- Letting us know when you are in pain
- Telling us about anything that is bothering you
- Treating staff members and others with respect
- Following rules and guidelines
- Keeping information about other people private—do not make video or audio recordings or take photos of other children, family members or staff members without permission
- Leaving all valuables at home
