Children's Rights and Responsibilities

You have the right to:

- Be treated with kindness and respect
- Have your questions answered in a way that you understand
- Receive help for any pain you feel
- Feel safe
- Be called the name you prefer
- Know the names and the roles of the people caring for you
- Make your own choices whenever possible
- Share your thoughts, feelings and concerns
- Get help from parents, caregivers and others whenever possible
- Have someone speak to you in the language you know best, whenever possible
- Have as much privacy as possible





As a patient at Kennedy Krieger, you have some important responsibilities to help everyone have a good experience.

You should:

- Talk with your team about how you feel, and ask any questions you may have
- Be honest
- Tell us when you are in pain
- Follow rules and instructions

- Treat staff, other patients and visitors with kindness and respect
- Respect other patients' privacy, and do not share their information
- Not take pictures or record videos of others without their permission
