The Early Childhood Development and Education Center (EDEC) provides a continuum of innovative, year-round early care and education supports and services to children with and without disabilities and their families.

Southeast Early Head Start (SEEHS) provides an attachment-based and trauma-responsive models of care designed to support very young children and their families living in Baltimore City who are experiencing a variety of high-risk factors such as community trauma, developmental delay and housing instability, as well as social determinant challenges faced by families. Services include early childhood and infant mental health therapy, family education, and developmental screenings, assessments and consultations.

Hours: M–F, 8:30 a.m.–3 p.m.

Transportation: Provided by family

Tuition: No cost based on eligibility

Food: No-cost meal program

Eligibility: Children 6 weeks through 3 years old who reside in Baltimore City and meet federal income requirements or federal categories of eligibility services



World of Care (WOC) provides the only accredited, comprehensive educational child care program in Maryland with an on-site nursing team, a skilled and dedicated teaching staff and access to multiple early intervention therapies to support infants and young children with and without disabilities, and their families.

Location: 7000 Tudsbury Road, Windsor Mill, Maryland 21244

Hours: M–F, 7:30 a.m.–5:30 p.m.

Transportation: Provided by family

Tuition: Self-pay and/or Maryland State Department of Education Child Care Scholarship, based on eligibility and availability

Eligibility: Children 6 weeks through 4 years old, with priority enrollment given to those with nursing and/or medical needs



Early Learning Classrooms (ELC) provides an inclusive preschool environment for children with and without disabilities. The classrooms integrate educational, medical, social-emotional and other therapeutic services to accelerate children's school readiness. Children play, explore and discover through an evidence-based curriculum, instruction and assessment model.

Location: 7000 Tudsbury Road, Windsor Mill, Maryland 21244

Hours: School year, M–F, 8:30 a.m.–3:30 p.m. (aftercare programming at an additional cost, based on availability)

Transportation: Provided by family

Food: No-cost meal program

Tuition: No cost to families who meet Maryland State Department of Education prekindergarten expansion program requirements. Otherwise, families may self-pay and/or receive tuition coverage (partial or full) through a Maryland State Department of Education Child Care Scholarship, based on eligibility and availability.

Eligibility: Children must be 3 or 4 years old by September 1 and meet Maryland State Department of Education prekindergarten expansion program requirements
