CRITERIA

- Child must be 3 or 4 years old on September 1 and must be a Maryland resident.
- Child/family must meet one of the following criteria:
 - Family income must be at or below 300% of the federal poverty line. Families will be asked to provide proof of income during the registration process.
 - Child must have a current IEP or Extended IFSP
 - English is not the primary language spoken in the home
 - Child/family is experiencing homelessness
- Family must provide transportation for their child.
- Parent/guardian participation in family engagement and family education activities is strongly encouraged.
