

2025 Designer Agreement

1. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- You must read and agree to all individual guidelines for your selected item(s).
- Registration fees are due at the time of registration and are non-refundable.
- Your **item is a donation to Kennedy Krieger Institute** and will be sold at Festival of Trees. **All included elements** are considered part of the donation and will go to the purchaser.
- A link to the required Designer Survey will be emailed on Monday, October 13. The survey
 must be submitted by Monday, October 27. (See individual item guidelines for more
 details).
- **Designer Days** will be held on **Saturday, November 22 through Monday, November 24.** You must **sign up for a decorating and/or drop-off time slot** in your **Designer Survey**. (See individual item guidelines for more details).
- As a thank you, you will receive complimentary general admission tickets and Designer Preview Party tickets. (See individual item guidelines for ticket quantities per item.)

2. EVENT SIGNAGE

- All signage is the property of Kennedy Krieger Institute. Only Festival of Trees staff can make changes or alterations.
- No decorations or stickers may be added to signs.
- Damage fees: \$50 for small signs, \$100 for large signs.
- Tree signage may be branded with sponsor companies/organizations. Designers may not alter this portion of the sign.

3. DESIGN RULES & RESTRICTIONS

- All electrical items must use UL-approved wiring and plug into standard 120V Edison outlets. Items not meeting these standards will not be plugged in.
- Special needs or requirements must be noted in the Designer Survey. Examples of special needs/requirements that would need to be noted:
 - A wreath or gingerbread that requires electricity.
 - Items that exceed the standard size(s) listed in the individual item guidelines. **Oversized designs will incur additional fees.**
- To ensure your item(s) can be moved and transported, all decorations, lights, and trim
 must be secured to the tree, wreath or gingerbread. Ornaments must be glued to their
 caps.

- No perishable items, wrapped or unwrapped, are allowed on or around the design. This includes dried fruit, popcorn garland, and bird seed ornaments.
- No spraying of aerosols is allowed inside the Cow Palace under any circumstances. This
 includes spray paint and snow flocking.
- Designs should be **creative but broadly appealing** to help ensure they sell.
- Avoid themes that include **social/political commentary**, **violence**, **profanity**, or **non-child-friendly** content.
- At Kennedy Krieger Institute, our commitment is to treat everyone with civility, dignity, and respect. To promote diversity and inclusion, please consider the representation of items such as dolls or figurines (e.g., Santa, angels) so that they reflect the diversity of our stakeholders.
 - All designs will be reviewed by the Festival of Trees Committee, if they feel your design does not reflect the above, they may alter your design. (You, the designer, will be notified prior to the event.)
 - The Festival of Trees Committee has the right to refuse to accept and display any item that it deems inappropriate.

4. SALE OF YOUR DESIGN

- All proceeds benefit Kennedy Krieger Institute.
- Pricing is set by the **Festival of Trees Committee** and may not reflect your costs.
- If you are interested in **buying your design back,** you *must* indicate this in your survey.
 - You'll be contacted on **Tuesday, November 25 (between 12pm–6pm)** with the price. You have **24 hours** to confirm and pay by credit card.
- Wreaths and 2-foot trees are sold as cash-and-carry items. Once a wreath or 2-foot tree
 has been purchased it will no longer be on display.
- Unsold items become property of the Institute and may be reused or donated.

5. JUDGING & AWARDS

- Awards will be given in multiple categories.
- Judging is subjective and final—no changes will be made once winners are selected.
- **Ribbons will be mailed** to winners after the event. Please **do not take** your ribbon with you.
