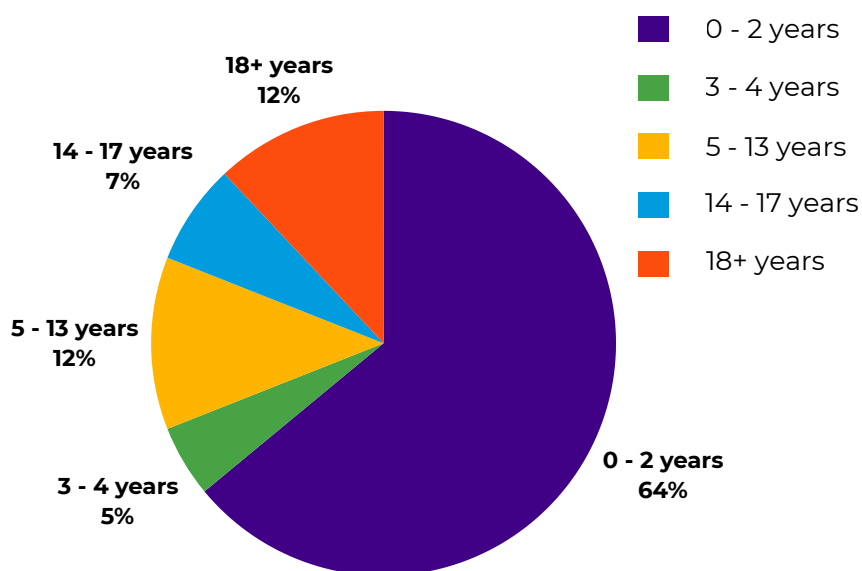

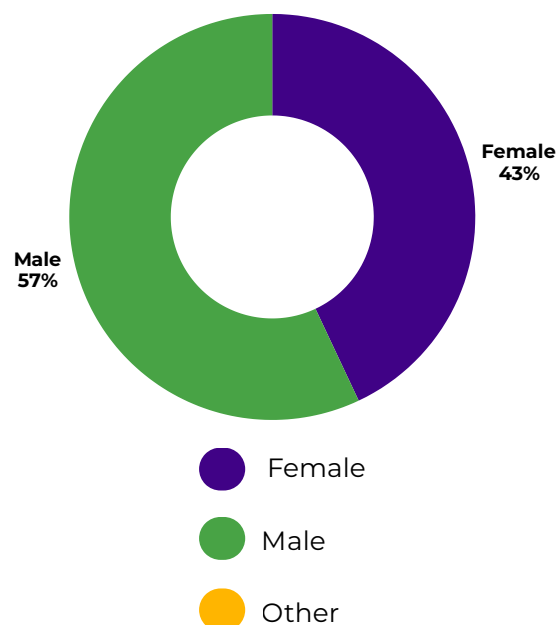
Who is treated in the Community Rehabilitation Program at Kennedy Krieger?

Age breakdown of patients:

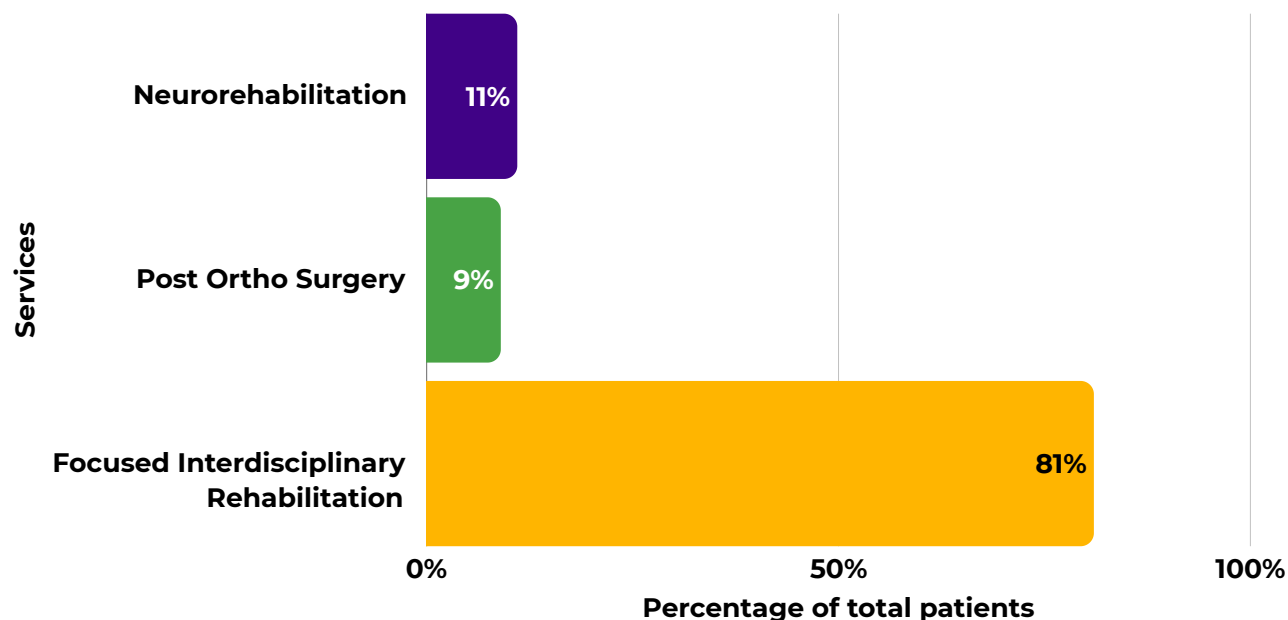


Gender Breakdown:



Rehabilitation Services Provided

The Community Rehabilitation Program treats infants, children and adolescents who, collectively, have a variety of rehabilitation needs.

Patients served in the Community Rehabilitation Program may have complex needs. An experienced interdisciplinary treatment team works with every patient and the family to address individual needs.

This team may include:

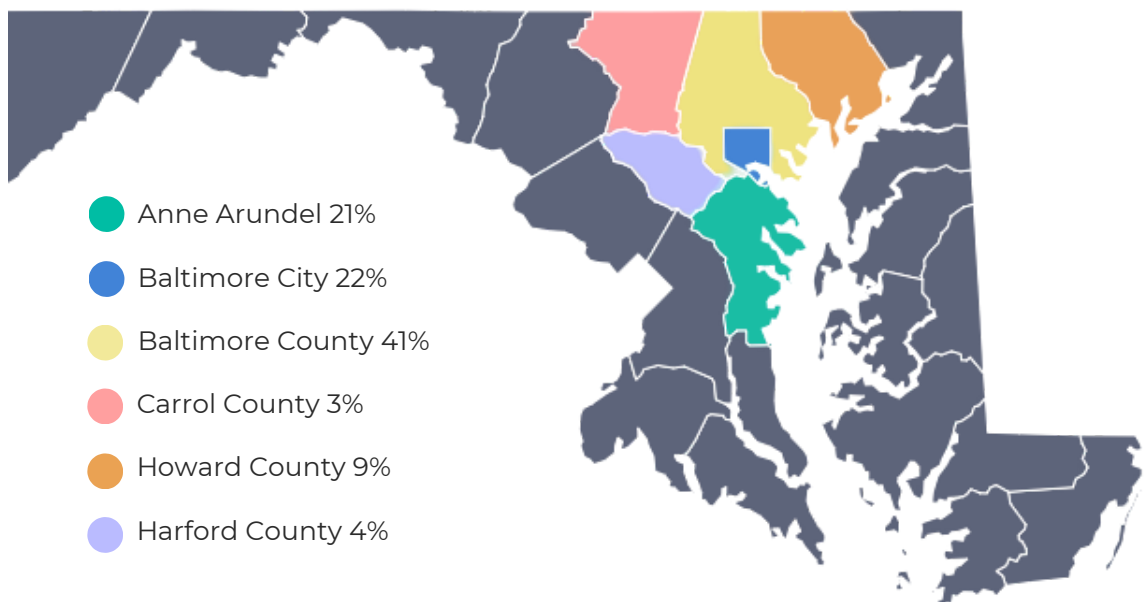
- Occupational therapists

Where do patients live who are seen by the Community Rehabilitation Program?

All of the patients treated in the Community Rehabilitation program in FY 25 were from Maryland.

How much therapy do patients being treated in the Community Rehabilitation Program receive?

Depending on the needs of the individual, patients in the Community Rehabilitation program receive 1-3 hours of therapy per week.

The treatment team evaluates each individual. Based on the results of these evaluations, the treatment team and the family develop a plan for community- based treatment.

What kinds of improvements might patients be expected to make while receiving treatment from the Community Rehabilitation Program?

Our outcome data support the effectiveness of our approach.

During fiscal year 2025*:



100% of patients met or exceeded WeeFIM goals



92% of primary admission goals were achieved by discharge



94% of families indicated that their children participated in home activities



Though medically fragile and homebound, with education and therapeutic intervention, 72% of Community Rehabilitation patients were able to participate in community activities.



100% of patients that were school age participated in school



Within 3 months of discharge from Community Rehabilitation, 84% of families experienced no unplanned hospitalizations



How is a patient and their family involved in the care received from the Community Rehabilitation Program?

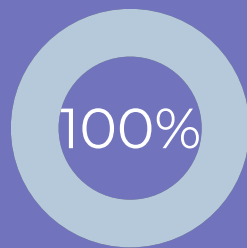


Families and caregivers are integral partners in the delivery of Community Rehabilitation's in-home therapy providing active participation in treatment planning and goal setting.

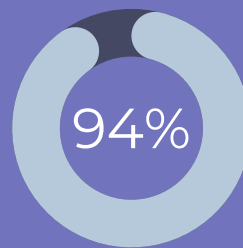
What do patients and their families say about their experience with the Community Rehabilitation Program?



During fiscal year 2025*:



100% of patients felt their therapists were effective



94% of caregivers were satisfied with the program
