

Plain Language Summary of Financial Assistance Policy

Kennedy Krieger Institute provides financial assistance for medically necessary care to eligible individuals and families on a sliding scale based on financial need. Two types of assistance are available, and information about eligibility, applying, and where to find more information is provided below.

You may be eligible if you meet the following criteria:

	U.S. citizen and Maryland resident Household income is less than 400% of the Federal Poverty Guideline Denied for governmental assistance programs such as Medicaid, Medicare, or MCHP		U.S. citizen and Maryland resident Household income is more than 400% of the Federal Poverty Guideline Medical bills more than 60% of household income		

Determination of Assistance: Assistance is awarded for Medical Indigency and Catastrophic Assistance as outlined below.
