

Do you have a child with CdLS?

Children with Cornelia de Lange syndrome, who are between the ages of 3 to 15 years old, are needed for a research study at the Kennedy Krieger Institute. Parents will initially be asked to complete questionnaires about their children's behavior and adaptive skills. Based on questionnaire results, families may be eligible to participate in the study, which entails completing additional questionnaires every 3 months for a period up to two years. During this time, we will monitor your child for changes in his/her behavior and daily functioning to better understand developmental and behavioral differences in children with CdLS.

Families will receive a \$10 gift card for returning the questionnaires every 3 months, and also have the option of attending a half-day clinic visit at the Kennedy Krieger Institute at no charge. Additionally, should your child experience changes in his/her behavior during the course of the study, we may provide referrals or offer free, brief assessment and treatment services at Kennedy Krieger Institute. Families of children who do not meet eligibility criteria based on results from the initial questionnaires will also receive a \$10 gift card for their participation.

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
