What is this research about?

- This research is trying to Identify markers of anxiety in children with autism
- Anxiety is common in children with autism and interferes with school and daily activities
- Identifying markers will help us develop treatments for anxiety

What is involved?

- Parents will answer questions about their child and about their own well-being
- Child will look at pictures on a computer
- Parents will receive \$50 for completing study measures

Who is eligible?

- Children 4 to 6 years old
- Diagnosis or suspected diagnosis of autism
- Anxiety or no anxiety we are looking for both groups!
