Seeking children 10-17 years who have NEVER had a concussion, for a research study

We are recruiting children who have never had a concussion as uninjured comparison participants in a research study about recovery from a concussion.

WHAT: Child will complete thinking tests and motor tasks and will have 3 brain Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scans. Parent will complete questionnaires.

Three 2-4 hour visits to Kennedy Krieger Institute are required. The second and third visits will be 3 and 12 months after visit one. Monthly surveys will be completed between visits.

WHERE: Kennedy Krieger Institute, Baltimore, MD

BENEFIT: There are no significant risks or direct medical benefits for participating in this study.
