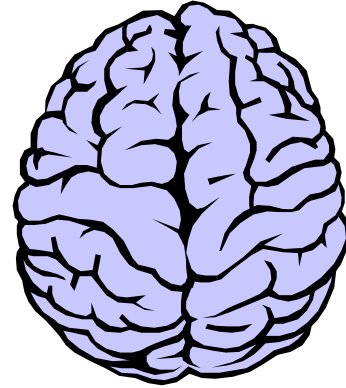


Take Part in Brain Injury Research!
