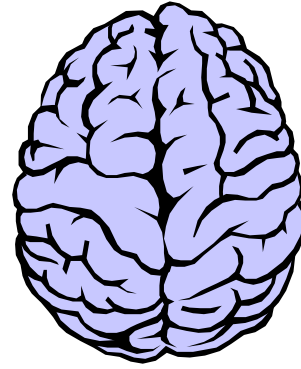


Take Part in Brain Injury Research!

We are recruiting typically developing children and their parents to participate in a MRI study about traumatic brain injury. We will compare information from typically developing children to information from children with brain injury, in order to better understand the effects of brain injury on a child's behavior.

WHAT: Child will complete paper and pencil and computer tasks and have one Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scan of the brain. Parent will complete questionnaires. Total of 1 visit to KKI required, lasting up to 5 hours long.
