### **VIRTUAL Undergraduate Programs**

**Maternal and Child Health Careers/Research Initiatives for Student Enhancement- Undergraduate Program (MCHC/RISE-UP)** is for undergraduate juniors, seniors, and scholars within 12 months of receiving their baccalaureate degree. MCHC/RISE-UP is led by three partnering programs (1) **Kennedy Krieger Institute** partnering with faculty at Johns Hopkins School of Medicine, Bloomberg School of Public Health, School of Nursing, and HBCU's (2) the **University of South Dakota** partnering with Tribal Serving Institutions, and (3) **University of California-Davis**. MCHC/RISE-UP Scholars may participate in up to two of three virtual public health leadership tracks, namely (1) clinical, (2) research, and (3) community engagement, and advocacy.
